



Texas Army National Guard State Tuition Reimbursement Program – (State TRP)
STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING – (SOU)

All active members of the Texas National Guard attending schools acceptable under the State Tuition Reimbursement Program – (State TRP) are able to apply for benefits. Applicants should be advised that funding from the State TRP is not guaranteed due to the program being a limited funds programming source (funds are based on funding availability).
To begin the application process, you must review and accept the Statement of Understanding. By providing your initials on each line you agree to honor the guidelines of the program IAW AGTX Regulation 621-5.

- 1. I understand the State TRP is a limited funds program and that submitting this application does not guarantee me approval.
2. I understand that only the max of 12 credit hours can be approved no matter how many schools or applications I submit.
3. I understand that funding can only be received for classes listed on my original application.
4. I understand that applications submitted outside of the deadline date will not be considered for benefits.
5. I understand that I can only receive benefits for 10 semesters of 5 academic years, whichever comes first.
6. I understand that I am limited to only one certificate, one associate’s degree, one bachelor’s degree, and one graduate degree. No lower or lateral degree will be funded.
7. I understand that during limited or reduced funding (less than two million dollars per year), reimbursement rates may be established at either (9), or (6) semester hours per student, per term or semester and master’s degree may not be funded.
8. I understand that State TRP will only provide funding for any course one time.
9. I understand that if I fail, withdraw, or receive an incomplete for a course, that course will NOT be funded and may be subject to recoupment.
10. I understand that failure to meet requirements needed to maintain my eligibility for Federal Tuition Assistance will also disqualify me for receiving funding from the State TRP.
11. I understand that any transferable and non-transferable flags will disqualify me for receiving funding from the State TRP.
